## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, SGC Resolution 23-02 is hereby repealed in its entirety; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT <u>FURTHER</u> RESOLVED, the Council directs the staff of <u>SGC</u> the Strategic Growth Council to coordinate with member agencies and departments of the <u>Council</u>, the <u>California</u> State Air Resources Board, and other state entities, as needed and beneficial to the State, on the development of a <u>modified</u> pilot funding program that:

- a) Evaluates the potential of <u>FBH</u> factory-built housing to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; and <u>contribute to the state's housing production and affordability goals; and</u>
- b) Assesses potential interventions to address challenges to the provision and deployment of FBH in California; and
- e) Provides funding to support the expansion of FBH in California. California facility expansion and/or establishment where the expansion would support an increased supply of housing units built in a factory setting; and
- d) The project is eligible for and applying for federal assistance to build, utilize, or expand clean energy infrastructure, create jobs, and reduce emissions.
